8	institution of higher education, the commission shall revise the
9	materials and methods for the training and development activities
10	to be provided under Subsection (b)(2).
11	SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, the executive
12	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
13	revise the materials and methods for the training and development
14	activities to be provided under Section 114.013(b)(2), Human
15	Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
