A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility requirements for receiving
- 3 distributions from the national research university fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 62.145(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A general academic teaching institution becomes
- 8 eligible to receive an initial distribution of money appropriated
- 9 under this subchapter for a state fiscal year if:
- 10 (1) the institution is designated as an emerging
- 11 research university under the coordinating board's accountability
- 12 system;
- 13 (2) in each of the two state fiscal years preceding the
- 14 state fiscal year for which the appropriation is made, the
- 15 institution expended at least \$45 million in restricted research
- 16 funds; and
- 17 (3) the institution:
- 18 <u>(A)</u> satisfies at least four of the following
- 19 criteria:
- 20 $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{(i)}}$] the value of the institution's
- 21 endowment funds is at least \$400 million in each of the two state
- 22 fiscal years preceding the state fiscal year for which the
- 23 appropriation is made;
- 24 (ii) [(B)] the institution awarded at least

- 1 200 doctor of philosophy degrees during each of the two academic
- 2 years preceding the state fiscal year for which the appropriation
- 3 is made;
- 4 $\underline{\text{(iii)}}$ [(C)] the entering freshman class of
- 5 the institution for each of those two academic years demonstrated
- 6 high academic achievement, as determined according to standards
- 7 prescribed by the coordinating board by rule, giving consideration
- 8 to the future educational needs of the state as articulated in the
- 9 coordinating board's "Closing the Gaps" report;
- 10 $\underline{\text{(iv)}}$ [\(\frac{\text{(iv)}}{D}\)] the institution is designated as
- 11 a member of the Association of Research Libraries or has a Phi Beta
- 12 Kappa chapter or has received an equivalent recognition of research
- 13 capabilities and scholarly attainment as determined according to
- 14 standards prescribed by the coordinating board by rule;
- (v) $[\frac{E}{E}]$ the faculty of the institution
- 16 for each of those two academic years was of high quality, as
- 17 determined according to coordinating board standards based on the
- 18 professional achievement and recognition of the institution's
- 19 faculty, including the election of faculty members to national
- 20 academies; and
- $\underline{\text{(vi)}}$ [\(\frac{\(\psi\)}{\(\psi\)}\)] for each of those two academic
- 22 years, the institution has demonstrated a commitment to
- 23 high-quality graduate education, as determined according to
- 24 standards prescribed by the coordinating board by rule, including
- 25 standards relating to the number of graduate-level programs at the
- 26 institution, the institution's admission standards for graduate
- 27 programs, and the level of institutional support for graduate

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- 1 students; or
- 2 (B) satisfies at least one of the criteria listed
- 3 in Paragraph (A) and is classified as an R1 doctorate-granting
- 4 university, or an equivalent designation if those classifications
- 5 are revised, under the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of
- 6 Higher Education.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
