- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 843.3042 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 843.3042. CHIROPRACTIC SERVICES. (a) A health
- 8 maintenance organization offering a health care plan that covers a
- 9 service that is within the scope of the practice of chiropractic as
- 10 <u>described</u> by <u>Section 201.002</u>, <u>Occupations Code</u>, <u>may not refuse to</u>
- 11 provide reimbursement to an in-network chiropractor for the
- 12 performance of the covered service solely because the service is
- 13 provided by a chiropractor.
- 14 (b) This section does not require a health maintenance
- 15 organization to cover a particular health care service.
- (c) This section does not affect the right of a health
- 17 maintenance organization to determine whether a health care service
- 18 <u>is medically necessary.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 1301.0516 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1301.0516. CHIROPRACTIC SERVICES. (a) An insurer
- 22 offering a preferred provider benefit plan, other than an exclusive
- 23 provider benefit plan, that covers a service that is within the
- 24 scope of the practice of chiropractic as described by Section

- 1 201.002, Occupations Code, may not refuse to provide reimbursement
- 2 for the performance of the covered service solely because the
- 3 service is provided by a chiropractor.
- 4 (b) An insurer offering an exclusive provider benefit plan
- 5 that covers a service that is within the scope of the practice of
- 6 chiropractic as described by Section 201.002, Occupations Code, may
- 7 not refuse to provide reimbursement to a chiropractor who is a
- 8 preferred provider for the performance of the covered service
- 9 solely because the service is provided by a chiropractor.
- 10 <u>(c) This section does not require an insurer to cover a</u>
- 11 particular medical or health care service.
- 12 (d) This section does not affect the right of an insurer to
- 13 determine whether a medical or health care service is medically
- 14 necessary.
- 15 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 17 renewed on or after January 1, 2020. A health benefit plan that is
- 18 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2020,
- 19 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 20 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 21 that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
