- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.3545, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (a), (b), and (f) and adding Subsection
- 7 (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A public institution of higher education selected by the
- 9 commission shall establish and offer a program of initial training
- 10 and a program of continuing education for constables. The
- 11 curriculum for each program must relate to law enforcement
- 12 management [and civil process issues]. The institution selected
- 13 under this subsection shall develop the curriculum for the
- 14 programs. The curriculum must be approved by the commission.
- 15 (b) Each constable must complete at least 40 hours of
- 16 continuing education provided by the selected institution under
- 17 Subsection (a) [this section] each 48-month period. The commission
- 18 by rule shall establish a uniform 48-month continuing education
- 19 training period.
- 20 (b-1) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (b),
- 21 during each 48-month continuing education training period each
- 22 constable must complete at least 20 hours of continuing education
- 23 instruction on civil process to be provided by a public institution
- 24 of higher education selected by the commission under this

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- 1 subsection. The commission shall establish minimum curriculum
- 2 requirements for the continuing education course on civil process
- 3 required by this subsection. The commission may waive the
- 4 continuing education requirements of this subsection if:
- 5 (1) a constable requests a waiver because of hardship;
- 6 <u>and</u>
- 7 (2) the commission determines that a hardship exists.
- 8 (f) An individual who is subject to the continuing education
- 9 requirements of Subsections [Subsection] (b) and (b-1) is exempt
- 10 from other continuing education requirements under this
- 11 subchapter.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
