

1 AN ACT

2 relating to cybersecurity of voter registration lists and other  
3 election-related documents, systems, and technology.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Title 16, Election Code, is amended by adding  
6 Chapter 279 to read as follows:

7 CHAPTER 279. CYBERSECURITY OF ELECTION SYSTEMS

8 Sec. 279.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

9 (1) "County election officer" means an individual  
10 employed by a county as an elections administrator, voter  
11 registrar, county clerk, or other officer with responsibilities  
12 relating to the administration of elections.

13 (2) "Election data" means information that is created  
14 or managed in the operation of an election system.

15 (3) "Election system" means a voting system and the  
16 technology used to support the conduct of an election, including  
17 the election data processed or produced in the course of conducting  
18 an election, such as voter registration information, ballot  
19 information, collected and tabulated votes, election management  
20 processes and procedures, and other election-related documents and  
21 election data.

22 Sec. 279.002. ELECTION CYBERSECURITY: SECRETARY OF STATE.

23 (a) The secretary of state shall adopt rules defining classes of  
24 protected election data and establishing best practices for

1 identifying and reducing risk to the electronic use, storage, and  
2 transmission of election data and the security of election systems.

3 (b) The secretary of state shall offer training on best  
4 practices:

5 (1) on an annual basis, to all appropriate personnel  
6 in the secretary of state's office; and

7 (2) on request, to county election officers in this  
8 state.

9 (c) If the secretary of state becomes aware of a breach of  
10 cybersecurity that impacts election data, the secretary shall  
11 immediately notify the members of the standing committees of each  
12 house of the legislature with jurisdiction over elections.

13 Sec. 279.003. ELECTION CYBERSECURITY: COUNTY ELECTION  
14 OFFICERS. (a) A county election officer shall annually request  
15 training on cybersecurity from the secretary of state. The  
16 secretary of state shall pay the costs associated with the training  
17 with available state funds.

18 (b) A county election officer shall request an assessment of  
19 the cybersecurity of the county's election system from a provider  
20 of cybersecurity assessments if the secretary of state recommends  
21 an assessment and the necessary funds are available.

22 (c) If a county election officer becomes aware of a breach  
23 of cybersecurity that impacts election data, the officer shall  
24 immediately notify the secretary of state.

25 (d) To the extent that state funds are available for the  
26 purpose, a county election officer shall implement cybersecurity  
27 measures to ensure that all devices with access to election data

1 comply to the highest extent possible with rules adopted by the  
2 secretary of state under Section 279.002.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
