A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a grant program to support the participation by certain
- 3 health care providers in TexasAIM.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Health and Safety Code, is amended by 6 adding Subchapter C to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER C. TEXASAIM GRANT PROGRAM

- 8 Sec. 32.061. TEXASAIM GRANT PROGRAM. (a) In this section,
- 9 "TexasAIM" means the program established by the department in
- 10 collaboration with the Alliance for Innovation on Maternal Health
- 11 and the Texas Hospital Association to assist health care providers
- 12 <u>in implementing maternal safety projects and decreasing incidents</u>
- 13 of preventable maternal death and severe maternal morbidity by
- 14 applying best practices for maternal safety and improving maternal
- 15 health care.

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- 16 (b) The department shall establish a grant program to
- 17 provide funding to health care providers who are located in rural or
- 18 medically underserved areas for travel and attendance costs
- 19 associated with attending TexasAIM collaborative learning
- 20 sessions. From available money and any additional money
- 21 appropriated for this purpose, the department shall award grants as
- 22 provided by this section.
- 23 <u>(c) The executive commissioner by rule shall establish</u>
- 24 eligibility criteria for awarding grants under this section. The

- 1 rules must require the department to consider:
- 2 <u>(1) a geographical area's need for impl</u>ementing
- 3 TexasAIM and the extent to which the grant would assist health care
- 4 providers in the area in meeting the identified need;
- 5 (2) the availability of other funding sources to meet
- 6 the identified need; and
- 7 (3) the participation by health care providers in
- 8 TexasAIM in the area.
- 9 (d) The department may approve grants according to
- 10 department rules. A grant awarded under this section is governed by
- 11 Chapter 783, Government Code, and rules adopted under that chapter.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the executive
- 13 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 14 adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 32.061, Health and
- 15 Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
