- 9 (h) Before a permit for a proposed municipal solid waste
- 10 management facility is issued, amended, extended, or renewed, the
- 11 commission shall inspect the facility or site used or proposed to be
- 12 used to store, process, or dispose of municipal solid waste to
- 13 confirm information included in the permit application. The
- 14 commission by rule shall prescribe the kinds of information in a
- 15 permit application that require confirmation under this
- 16 subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 an application for a permit, license, registration, or other
- 19 authorization for a municipal solid waste facility that is filed
- 20 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. An application for a permit, license,
- 22 registration, or other authorization for a municipal solid waste
- 23 facility that is filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, and that law is

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
