- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 411.0725(e), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (e) A person may petition the court that placed the person
- 10 on deferred adjudication community supervision for an order of
- 11 nondisclosure of criminal history record information under this
- 12 section only on or after:
- 13 (1) the discharge and dismissal, if the offense for
- 14 which the person was placed on deferred adjudication was a
- 15 misdemeanor other than a misdemeanor described by Subdivision (2);
- 16 (2) the first [second] anniversary of the discharge
- 17 and dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on
- 18 deferred adjudication was a misdemeanor under Chapter 20, 21, 22,
- 19 25, 42, 43, or 46, Penal Code; [or]
- 20 (3) the first anniversary of the discharge and
- 21 dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on
- 22 <u>deferred adjudication was a state jail felony under Chapter 481,</u>
- 23 Health and Safety Code, listed in Article 42A.551(a), Code of
- 24 Criminal Procedure; or

- 1 $\underline{\text{(4)}}$ the $\underline{\text{third}}$ [fifth] anniversary of the discharge and
- 2 dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on
- 3 deferred adjudication was a felony, other than a state jail felony
- 4 <u>described by Subdivision (3)</u>.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
