- 2 relating to an election officer providing and receiving an

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 61, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 61.015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 61.015. APPLICATION FOR EARLY VOTING BALLOT AT POLLING
- 8 PLACE. (a) An election officer may provide to and accept from a
- 9 voter who qualifies to receive ballots to be voted by mail under
- 10 Section 86.0015, an application for a ballot to be voted by mail and
- 11 may provide instructions for submitting the application under
- 12 <u>Section 86.0015.</u>
- 13 (b) An election officer may post at a polling place a sign in
- 14 the form prescribed by the secretary of state under Subsection (c)
- 15 that refers to the availability of application forms for an early
- 16 voting ballot to be voted by mail if the election officers have the
- 17 applications.
- 18 <u>(c) The secretary of state:</u>
- 19 (1) shall prescribe a sign that may be posted at a
- 20 polling place that refers to the availability of application forms
- 21 for an early voting ballot to be voted by mail; and
- 22 (2) may adopt rules as necessary to implement this
- 23 section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
