4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 85.005(c), Election Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 (c) In a county with a population of 50,000 [100,000] or

8 more, the voting in a primary election or the general election for

9 state and county officers shall be conducted at the main early

10 voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each weekday of the

11 last week of the early voting period, and the voting in a special

12 election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the main

13 early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each of the last

14 two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be conducted in

15 accordance with this subsection in those elections in a county with

16 a population under 50,000 [100,000] on receipt by the early voting

17 clerk of a written request for the extended hours submitted by at

18 least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be

19 submitted not later than the 60th day before the date early voting

20 <u>begins</u> [in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067].

21 SECTION 2. Section 85.006(e), Election Code, is amended to

22 read as follows:

(e) In a primary election or the general election for state

- $[\frac{100,000}{}]$ or more, the early voting clerk shall order personal 1 appearance voting at the main early voting polling place to be 2 conducted for at least 12 hours on the last Saturday and for at 3 4 least five hours on the last Sunday of the early voting period. The early voting clerk shall order voting to be conducted at those times 5 6 in those elections in a county with a population under 50,000[100,000] on receipt of a written request for those hours submitted 7 8 by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be 9 submitted not later than the 60th day before the date early voting begins [in time to enable compliance with Section 85.007]. This 10 subsection supersedes any provision of this subchapter to the 11 extent of any conflict. 12
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
