- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 86.007(a) and (e), Election Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A [Except as provided by Subsection (d), a] marked
- 7 ballot voted by mail must arrive at the address on the carrier
- 8 envelope:
- 9 (1) before the time the polls are required to close on
- 10 election day; or
- 11 (2) not later than the fifth day after the date of the
- 12 <u>election</u> [5 p.m. on the day after election day], if the carrier
- 13 envelope was placed for delivery by mail or common or contract
- 14 carrier before election day and bears a cancellation mark of a
- 15 common or contract carrier or a courier indicating a time not later
- 16 than 7 p.m. at the location of the election on election day.
- (e) A delivery under Subsection (a)(2) [or (d)] is timely,
- 18 except as otherwise provided by this title, if the carrier envelope
- 19 or, if applicable, the envelope containing the carrier envelope:
- 20 (1) is properly addressed with postage or handling
- 21 charges prepaid; and
- 22 (2) bears a cancellation mark of a recognized postal
- 23 service or a receipt mark of a common or contract carrier or a
- 24 courier indicating a time before the deadline.

- 1 SECTION 2. Sections 87.125(a) and (a-1), Election Code, are 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) The early voting ballot board shall convene to count
- 4 ballots voted by mail that arrive at the address on the carrier
- 5 envelope after 5 p.m. on the day after election day and are timely
- 6 under Section 86.007 [described by Section 86.007(d)] at the time
- 7 set by the presiding judge of the board on the ninth day after the
- 8 date of an election or on an earlier day if the early voting clerk
- 9 certifies that all ballots voted by mail [mailed from outside the
- 10 United States | have been received.
- 11 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for an election held
- 12 on the date of the general election for state and county officers,
- 13 the early voting ballot board shall convene to count ballots voted
- 14 by mail that arrive at the address on the carrier envelope after 5
- 15 p.m. on the day after election day and are timely under Section
- 16 86.007 [described by Sections 86.007(d) and (d-1)] not later than
- 17 the 13th day after the date of the election.
- SECTION 3. Sections 86.007(d) and (g), Election Code, are
- 19 repealed.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
