- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 74.501, Property Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 8 follows:

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- 9 (e) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (f) <u>and</u>
- 10 (g), the comptroller may not pay to the following persons a claim to
- 11 which this section applies:
- 12 (1) a creditor, a judgment creditor, a lienholder, or
- 13 an assignee of the reported owner or of the owner's heirs; or
- 14 (2) a person holding a power of attorney from the
- 15 reported owner or the owner's heirs.
- 16 (g) The comptroller may approve a claim for unclaimed
- 17 property submitted by a claimant who was a victim of a criminal
- 18 offense for which the reported owner of the unclaimed property was
- 19 <u>finally convicted if on the date the claim is submitted:</u>
- 20 (1) the claimant is entitled to payment from the
- 21 reported owner under:
- (A) a final judgment against the reported owner
- 23 <u>related to that criminal offense; or</u>
- 24 (B) a final order of restitution under Article

- 2 offense; and
- 3 (2) the reported owner is incarcerated in federal
- 4 custody or the custody of this or any state based on any final
- 5 criminal conviction.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a claim filed under Section 74.501, Property Code, on or after
- 8 the effective date of this Act. A claim filed under that section
- 9 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 10 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 11 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
