SECTION 1. Section 1001.002, Education Code, is amended by
adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
(a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), ar
organization is exempt from this chapter and any fee imposed under
this chapter if the organization:
(1) is exempt from federal taxation under Section
501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described
by Section 501(c)(3) of that code; and
(2) provides to individuals who are at least 50 years
of age a driving safety course that may be used for purposes of
Article 45.0511, Code of Criminal Procedure.
(a-2) Sections 1001.0561, 1001.351(b), 1001.451, and
1001.555 apply to an organization described by Subsection (a-1).
SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is
amended by adding Section 1001.0561 to read as follows:
