18	psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or the
19	American Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry;
20	(6) one member who has expertise in providing veterans
21	with information on the programs, services, and other resources
22	that are available to veterans in this state; and

- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 4 511.004(a), Government Code, does not affect the entitlement of a
- 5 member serving on the Commission on Jail Standards immediately
- 6 before the effective date of this Act to continue to serve for the
- 7 remainder of the member's term. As the terms of members expire, the
- 8 governor shall appoint or reappoint members to the Commission on
- 9 Jail Standards who have the qualifications required by Section
- 10 511.004, Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
