A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the consideration of ownership interests of certain
3	persons with disabilities in determining whether a business is a
4	historically underutilized business for purposes of state
5	contracting.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 2161.001(3), Government Code, is amended
8	to read as follows:
9	(3) "Economically disadvantaged person" means a
10	person who:
11	(A) is economically disadvantaged because of the
12	person's identification as a member of a certain group, including:
13	(i) Black Americans;
14	(ii) Hispanic Americans;
15	(iii) women;
16	(iv) Asian Pacific Americans;
17	(v) Native Americans; [and]
18	(vi) veterans as defined by 38 U.S.C.
19	Section 101(2) who have suffered at least a 20 percent
20	service-connected disability as defined by 38 U.S.C. Section
21	101(16); <u>and</u>
22	(vii) persons with a disability as defined
23	by 42 U.S.C. Section 12102; and
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- 1 (B) has suffered the effects of discriminatory
- 2 practices or other similar insidious circumstances over which the
- 3 person has no control.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 2161.002, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 6 (e) The comptroller shall adopt rules to provide goals for
- 7 increasing the contract awards for the purchase of goods or
- 8 services by the commission and other state agencies to businesses
- 9 that qualify as historically underutilized businesses because the
- 10 businesses are owned or owned, operated, and controlled, as
- 11 applicable, wholly or partly by one or more persons with a
- 12 disability as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 12102. The goals
- 13 established under this subsection are in addition to the goals
- 14 established under Subsections (c) and (d), and the goals
- 15 established under Subsections (c) and (d) may not be reduced as a
- 16 result of the establishment of goals under this subsection.
- SECTION 3. Section 2161.061, Government Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 19 <u>(f) To be certified by the commission as a historically</u>
- 20 underutilized business, a business owned by one or more persons who
- 21 qualify as economically disadvantaged solely based on being a
- 22 person with a disability must submit to the commission an affidavit
- 23 from the physician of each owner claiming a disability verifying
- 24 that owner's disability.
- 25 SECTION 4. Section 2161.125, Government Code, is amended to
- 26 read as follows:
- 27 Sec. 2161.125. CATEGORIZATION OF HISTORICALLY

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- 1 UNDERUTILIZED BUSINESSES. The comptroller, in cooperation with
- 2 each state agency reporting under this subchapter, shall categorize
- 3 each historically underutilized business included in a report under
- 4 this subchapter by sex, race, and ethnicity and by whether the
- 5 business qualifies as a historically underutilized business
- 6 because it is owned or owned, operated, and controlled, as
- 7 applicable, wholly or partly by one or more persons with a
- 8 disability as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 12102 or one or more
- 9 veterans as defined by 38 U.S.C. Section 101(2) who have suffered at
- 10 least a 20 percent service-connected disability as defined by 38
- 11 U.S.C. Section 101(16).
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
