4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Labor Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 21.013 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.013. SEXUAL HARASSMENT PREVENTION TRAINING AND
8	INFORMATION. (a) In this section, the term "supervisor" includes a
9	person with the authority to direct an employee's daily activities
10	while at work, regardless of whether the person has the authority to
11	hire, fire, or take other tangible employment action with respect
12	to the employee.
13	(b) At least once every two years, an employer other than a
14	state agency shall provide to each employee of the employer at
15	least:
16	(1) two hours of sexual harassment prevention
17	training, if the employee is a supervisor; and
18	(2) one hour of sexual harassment prevention training,
19	if the employee is not a supervisor.
20	(c) The commission shall develop or obtain, and make
21	available on its Internet website, one-hour and two-hour sexual
22	harassment prevention training videos that may be used by employers
23	to provide the training required by this section.
24	(d) The commission shall develop and make available on its

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Internet website for use by employers informational posters and 1 fact sheets displaying information regarding the prevention of 2 sexual harassment. 3 4 (e) The commission may adopt rules as necessary for the administration of this section. 5 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas 6 Workforce Commission shall post on its Internet website the videos, 7 posters, and fact sheets required by Section 21.013, Labor Code, as 8 added by this Act. 9

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
