4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2306.2591 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.2591. GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN HOUSING RELIEF LOAN
8	PROGRAM. (a) The department shall establish and administer a
9	program to provide loans to federal employees who are:
10	(1) considered nonessential or otherwise furloughed
11	during a federal government shutdown; or
12	(2) working without pay during a federal government
13	shutdown as a result of being considered essential or otherwise
14	excepted from a furlough.
15	(b) A loan made under this section:
16	(1) may be made only for rent, mortgage, or utility
17	<pre>payments;</pre>
18	(2) must be repaid not later than the 60th day after
19	the date the federal government processes back pay for the loan
20	recipient following the end of a federal government shutdown; and
21	(3) may not bear interest.
22	(c) The department shall adopt rules necessary to
23	administer the program. Rules adopted under this section:
24	(1) must include requirements for documentation

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- 1 necessary for a loan applicant to establish eligibility for
- 2 participation in the program, including proof of employment and
- 3 covered expenses; and
- 4 (2) may impose fees for the failure to repay a loan
- 5 within the period required by Subsection (b)(2).
- 6 (d) The department may use any available revenue, including
- 7 any available money from the housing trust fund, to provide loans
- 8 under this section. The department shall solicit and accept gifts
- 9 and grants for the purposes of this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
