A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the administration of federal funds under the 3 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2306.111(c), (c-1), and (c-2), Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (c) In administering federal housing funds provided to the state under the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act 8 9 (42 U.S.C. Section 12701 et seq.), the department shall allocate 10 [expend]: 95 percent of these funds for the benefit of (1)11 12 non-participating small cities and rural areas that do not qualify to receive funds under the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable 13 14 Housing Act directly from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, except that an amount not to exceed 15 15 percent of the funds allocated under this subdivision may be 16 allocated to participating jurisdictions as necessary to meet the 17 requirements of federal law; and 18 (2) five percent of these funds for the benefit of 19 20 persons with disabilities who live in any area of this state. 21 (c-1) Eligibility to apply for set-aside funds under Subsection (c) is determined by federal law [The following entities 22 23 are eligible to apply for set-aside funds under Subsection (c): [(1) nonprofit providers of affordable housing, 24

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including community housing development organizations; and 1 [(2) for-profit providers of affordable housing]. 2 (c-2) In allocating set-aside funds under Subsection (c), 3 the department: 4 5 (1) may not give preference to nonprofit providers of 6 affordable housing, except as necessary to meet the requirements of 7 [required by] federal law; and 8 (2) shall allocate funds in accordance with any applicable spending plan required under federal law. 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in amending 10 Section 2306.111, Government Code, applies only to an application 11 for financial assistance that is submitted to the Texas Department 12 of Housing and Community Affairs on or after January 1, 2020. 13 An application for financial assistance that is submitted to the 14 15 department before January 1, 2020, is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former 16 law is continued in effect for that purpose. 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 18

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
