 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the Texas State Guard uniform and insignia fund.
 1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-20 SECTION 1. Section 437.310(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-21 to read as follows:
 1-22 (b) The fund consists of:
 1-23 (1) donations made to the fund;
 1-24 (2) revenue received by the Texas State Guard from the
 1-25 sale of uniforms and insignia to members of the guard; ~~and~~
 1-26 (3) depository interest and investment income earned
 1-27 on money in the fund; and
 1-28 (4) money appropriated, credited, or transferred to
 1-29 the fund by the legislature.
 1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-31 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-32 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-33 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-34 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
