- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 371.002, Finance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 371.002. PURPOSES. The purposes of this chapter are
- 7 to:
- prevent fraud, unfair practices, discrimination, 8 (1)
- 9 imposition, and abuse of state residents;
- exercise the state's police power to ensure a sound 10
- system of making pawn loans and transfers of personal property by 11
- 12 and through pawnshops;
- 13 (3) prevent transactions in stolen property and other
- 14 unlawful property transactions by licensing and regulating
- pawnbrokers [and pawnshop employees]; 15

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- 1 amended by adding Section 371.074 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 371.074. PAWNBROKER RESPONSIBLE FOR EMPLOYEES AND
- 3 AGENTS. A license holder under this subchapter is responsible for
- 4 all acts of the license holder's officers, directors, employees,
- 5 and agents acting on behalf of the pawnshop.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 371.257(a), Finance Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) The holder of a pawnshop license [or a pawnshop employee
- 9 license may surrender the license by delivering it to the
- 10 commissioner with written notice of surrender.
- SECTION 4. Sections 371.258(a) and (b), Finance Code, are
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) This section applies to a pawnshop license [or a
- 14 pawnshop employee license].
- 15 (b) The commissioner may reinstate a suspended pawnshop
- 16 license [or pawnshop employee license] or issue a new license to the
- 17 person whose license or licenses have been revoked if no fact or
- 18 condition exists that clearly would have justified refusal to issue
- 19 the license originally.
- SECTION 5. Section 371.259, Finance Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 371.259. CERTIFICATE OF STANDING; COPIES. The
- 23 commissioner, under the commissioner's seal and signature, shall
- 24 provide a certificate of good standing or a certified copy of a
- 25 pawnshop license [or a pawnshop employee license] to a person who
- 26 applies and pays for the certificate or copy.
- 27 SECTION 6. The following provisions of the Finance Code are

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- 2 (1) Subchapter C, Chapter 371;
- 3 (2) Sections 371.255 and 371.256; and
- 4 (3) Sections 371.304(b), (c), and (d).
- 5 SECTION 7. (a) On the effective date of this Act, a license
- 6 issued under former Section 371.104, Finance Code, expires.
- 7 (b) The repeal of a law by this Act does not entitle a person
- 8 to a refund of an application, licensing, or other fee paid by the
- 9 person before the effective date of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
- 11 the validity of a disciplinary action or other proceeding that was
- 12 initiated before the effective date of this Act and that is pending
- 13 before a court or other governmental entity on that date.
- 14 SECTION 9. (a) A violation of a law that is repealed by
- 15 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the violation
- 16 was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- 18 (b) For purposes of this section, a violation was committed
- 19 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the
- 20 violation occurred before that date.
- 21 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
