7 CHAPTER 15A. DISTILLERY FESTIVAL PERMIT

- 8 Sec. 15A.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of a
- 9 distillery festival permit may sell distilled spirits at a civic or
- 10 <u>alcoholic beverage festival</u>, farmers' market, celebration, or
- 11 similar event.

- 3 Sec. 15A.04. PERMIT FEE. The fee for a distillery festival
- 4 permit is \$50.
- 5 Sec. 15A.05. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. The provisions of
- 6 this code applicable to the sale of distilled spirits on the
- 7 permitted premises of the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's
- 8 permit apply to the sale of distilled spirits under this chapter.
- 9 Sec. 15A.06. EFFECT OF VIOLATION ON DISTILLER'S AND
- 10 RECTIFIER'S PERMIT. The distiller's and rectifier's permit of the
- 11 holder of a distillery festival permit may be canceled or suspended
- 12 for a violation occurring in connection with activities conducted
- 13 under this chapter.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
