8	RESPONDER. (a) In this section, "emergency services personnel"
9	has the meaning assigned by Section 22.01.
10	(b) A person commits an offense if, with the intent to
11	deceive, the person:
12	(1) knowingly makes a false report that a peace
13	officer or emergency services personnel, while performing official
14	duties, engaged in conduct that violates a law of this state,
15	another state, or the United States or conduct that violates any
16	applicable internal policy or code of conduct of the law
17	enforcement agency or emergency services provider employing or
18	supervising the officer or personnel; and
19	(2) makes the report to:
20	(A) any law enforcement agency for the purpose of

- 3 (c) An offense under this section is, if it is shown on the
- 4 trial of the offense that the false report consisted of an
- 5 allegation of conduct that violates a penal law of this state, the
- 6 greater of one category of offense lower than the most serious
- 7 offense falsely reported or a Class A misdemeanor.
- 8 (d) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor
- 9 if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the false report
- 10 consisted of an allegation of conduct that violates a law of this
- 11 state, another state, or the United States, other than a penal law
- 12 of this state, or violates an internal policy or code of conduct of
- 13 the applicable law enforcement agency or emergency services
- 14 provider.
- 15 (e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
- 16 section also constitutes an offense under another law, the actor
- 17 may be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
