A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. 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received for the 2019-2020 school year under the district's salary 1 schedule for the 2018-2019 school year, if that schedule had been in 2 effect for the 2019-2020 school year, including any local 3 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement 4 5 the employee would have received in the 2019-2020 school year; and 6 (2) \$2,500. 7 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September 8 1, 2020. 9 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 10 nurse employed by a school district in the 2019-2020 school year is, 11 12 as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee 13 14 received for the 2019-2020 school year.

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15 (q) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the application of this section, including rules that: 16

17 (1)require the payment of a minimum salary under this section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a 18 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those 19 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and 20

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specify the credentials a person must hold to be (2) considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this section.

24 SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 25

A school district, including a school district that is 26 (a) 27 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled

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1 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:

2 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of 3 full-time district employees, other than administrators or 4 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 5 21.402; [and]

6 (2) <u>the product of \$25,000 multiplied by the number of</u>
7 <u>classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time school</u>
8 <u>counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time</u>
9 <u>school nurses employed by the district; and</u>

10 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of 11 part-time district employees, other than administrators.

SECTION 3. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is repealed.

SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.

16 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
