- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1601.265(a), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Subject to Section 1603.2545, the [The] department
- 8 shall issue a license or certificate to an applicant for a license
- 9 or certificate issued under Section 1601.253, 1601.256, or 1601.258
- 10 if the applicant:
- 11 (1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the
- 12 department;
- 13 (2) pays the application fee; and
- 14 (3) provides proof that the applicant holds a current
- 15 license to engage in the same or a similar activity issued by
- 16 another jurisdiction that has license requirements substantially
- 17 equivalent to those of this state.
- SECTION 2. Section 1601.402, Occupations Code, is amended
- 19 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a Class A barber or
- 21 barber technician may not renew a certificate or license issued
- 22 under Section 1601.253 or 1601.256 unless the person has passed an
- 23 examination administered under Section 1603.2545. This subsection
- 24 expires June 1, 2022.

- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 1603, Occupations Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 1603.2545 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 1603.2545. EXAMINATION FOR CERTAIN CLASS A BARBER
- 4 CERTIFICATE OR BARBER TECHNICIAN LICENSE APPLICANTS. An applicant
- 5 under Section 1601.265 for a Class A barber certificate or barber
- 6 technician license must pass an examination prescribed by the
- 7 department. The content of the examination must focus on customer
- 8 safety, including sanitary and hygiene requirements.
- 9 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas
- 10 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary
- 11 to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- 12 (b) The changes in law made by this Act with respect to the
- 13 issuance of a certificate or license apply only to an application
- 14 for the issuance of a Class A barber certificate or barber
- 15 technician license submitted on or after January 1, 2020. An
- 16 application for the issuance of a Class A barber certificate or
- 17 barber technician license submitted before that date is governed by
- 18 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 (c) Section 1601.402(d), Occupations Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, applies only to a Class A barber certificate or barber
- 22 technician license that expires on or after January 1, 2020. A
- 23 certificate or license that expires before that date is governed by
- 24 the law in effect on the date the certificate or license expired,
- 25 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
