H.B. No. 1647

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to Medicaid reimbursement for dental services provided to  
3 adults with disabilities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.054, Human Resources Code, is amended  
6 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

7 (f) The commission shall provide medical assistance  
8 reimbursement for dental services, including preventive dental  
9 services, for an adult recipient with a disability to prevent  
10 serious medical conditions and reduce emergency room visits by the  
11 recipient necessitated by complications resulting from a lack of  
12 access to dental care.

13 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act  
14 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a  
15 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,  
16 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or  
17 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the  
18 waiver or authorization is granted.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
