- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 386.154(d), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A new light-duty motor vehicle powered by an electric
- 8 drive is eligible for a \$2,500 incentive if the vehicle:
- 9 (1) has four wheels <u>or is a motorcycle as defined by</u>
- 10 <u>541.201</u>, Transportation Code;
- 11 (2) was manufactured for use primarily on public
- 12 streets, roads, and highways;
- 13 (3) has not been modified from the original
- 14 manufacturer's specifications;
- 15 (4) has a maximum speed capability of at least 55 miles
- 16 per hour;
- 17 (5) is propelled to a significant extent by an
- 18 electric motor that draws electricity from a hydrogen fuel cell or
- 19 from a battery that:
- 20 (A) has a capacity of not less than four kilowatt
- 21 hours; and
- 22 (B) is capable of being recharged from an
- 23 external source of electricity; and
- 24 (6) was acquired on or after September 1, 2013, or a

- 1 later date as established by the commission, by the person applying
- 2 for the incentive under this subsection and for use or lease by that
- 3 person and not for resale.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
