## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-21 1-22 AN ACT

relating to the amount of and vehicles eligible for the light-duty motor vehicle purchase or lease incentive program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 386.154(d), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- A new light-duty motor vehicle powered by an electric (d) drive is eligible for a \$2,500 incentive if the vehicle:
- (1)has four wheels or is a motorcycle as defined by , Transportation Code; Section 541.201
- (2) was manufactured for use primarily on public streets, roads, and highways;
- (3) has not been modified from the manufacturer's specifications;
- (4)has a maximum speed capability of at least 55 miles per hour;
- is propelled to a significant extent by an electric motor that draws electricity from a hydrogen fuel cell or from a battery that:
- (A) has a capacity of not less than four kilowatt hours; and
- 1-42 1-43 (B) is capable of being recharged from an 1-44 external source of electricity; [and]
  - was acquired on or after September 1, 2013, or a (6) later date as established by the commission, by the person applying for the incentive under this subsection and for use or lease by that person and not for resale; and
- 1-49 (7) is not a motor-assisted scooter, pocket bike, or minimotorbike as those terms are defined by Section 551.351, 1-50 1-51
- Transportation Code.

  SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-52 1-53 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-54 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-55 1-56 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
