## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the availability of dates of birth under the public

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 552.0222 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.0222. DATES OF BIRTH. Notwithstanding Section
- 8 <u>552.101</u>, this chapter does not authorize a governmental body to
- 9 withhold a date of birth except as:
- 10 (1) permitted by Section 552.102;
- 11 (2) permitted by the federal privacy requirements
- 12 adopted under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability
- 13 Act of 1996 (Pub. L. No. 104-191) contained in 45 C.F.R. Part 160
- 14 and 45 C.F.R. Part 164; or
- 15 (3) otherwise provided by constitutional or statutory
- 16 law.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 19 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 20 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 22 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
