5 SECTION 1. Chapter 13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

amended by adding Article 13.072 to read as follows:

- 8 COMMITTED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY. An offense under Section 25.11,
- 9 Penal Code, may be prosecuted in any county in which the defendant
- 10 engaged in the conduct constituting an offense under Section
- 11 22.01(a)(1), Penal Code, against a person described by Section
- 12 <u>25.11(a)</u>, Penal Code.

- SECTION 2. Section 25.11, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 14 Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 15 <u>(a-1)</u> It is not a defense to prosecution under this section
- 16 that the conduct occurred in more than one county in this state.
- 17 (b) If the jury is the trier of fact, members of the jury are
- 18 not required to agree unanimously on the specific conduct in which
- 19 the defendant engaged that constituted an offense under Section
- 20 22.01(a)(1) against the person or persons described by Subsection
- 21 (a), [or the exact date when that conduct occurred, or the county
- 22 in which each instance of the conduct occurred. The jury must agree
- 23 unanimously that the defendant, during a period that is 12 months or
- 24 less in duration, two or more times engaged in conduct that

- 1 constituted an offense under Section 22.01(a)(1) against the person
- 2 or persons described by Subsection (a).
- 3 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 4 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 5 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 6 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 7 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 8 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 9 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
