5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 502.4021 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 502.4021. OPTIONAL COUNTY FEE FOR REGIONAL
8	<pre>IMPROVEMENTS. (a) This section applies only to a county that:</pre>
9	(1) borders the United Mexican States and the Gulf of
10	Mexico; or
11	(2) borders a county described by Subdivision (1).
12	(b) The commissioners court of a county by order may impose
13	an additional fee of \$2 for a vehicle registered in the county if
14	approved by a majority of the qualified voters of the county voting
15	at an election, which the commissioners court may order and hold for
16	that purpose.
17	(c) A vehicle that may be registered under this chapter

 19 section without payment of the additional fee.
- 20 (d) A fee imposed under this section may take effect and be 21 removed in accordance with the requirements of Section 502.401.
- 22 <u>(e) The additional fee shall be collected for a vehicle when</u>
 23 <u>other fees imposed under this chapter are collected.</u>
- 24 (f) The county shall:

- 1 (1) send 50 percent of the fee revenue collected to a
- 2 regional planning commission, council of governments, or similar
- 3 regional planning agency created under Chapter 391, Local
- 4 Government Code, in which the county is located; and
- 5 (2) send 50 percent of the fee revenue collected to
- 6 municipalities in the county, distributed in proportion to their
- 7 populations.
- 8 (g) A commission, council, or agency may use revenue
- 9 received under Subsection (f)(1) only to fund public transportation
- 10 <u>services.</u>
- 11 (h) A municipality may use revenue received under
- 12 Subsection (f)(2) only to fund road or drainage projects.
- 13 (i) The department shall adopt rules necessary to
- 14 administer registration for a vehicle being registered in a county
- 15 imposing a fee under this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
