## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a comprehensive plan for increasing and improving the workforce in this state that serves persons with mental health and 3 substance use issues. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 531.02253 to read as follows: Sec. 531.02253. COMPREHENSIVE WORKFORCE PLAN FOR MENTAL 8 HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE. (a) The commission shall develop and 9 implement a comprehensive plan to increase and improve the 10 workforce in this state to serve persons with mental health and 11 substance use issues. In developing the plan, the commission shall 12 analyze and consider available studies, reports, and 13 14 recommendations regarding that segment of the workforce in this 15 state or elsewhere. 16 (b) The plan must include: (1) a strategy and timeline for implementing the plan, 17 including short-term, medium-term, and long-term goals; 18 (2) a system for monitoring the implementation of the 19 20 plan; and 21 (3) a method for evaluating the outcomes of the plan. 22 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2020, the Health and 23 Human Services Commission shall develop and begin implementing the plan required under Section 531.02253, Government Code, as added by 24

2	SECTION 3.	This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
