| 5  | SECTION 1. Section 437.020(a)(2), Health and Safety Code,            |
| 6  | is amended to read as follows:                                       |
| 7  | (2) "Food" means an agricultural, apicultural,                       |
| 8  | horticultural, silvicultural, viticultural, or vegetable product     |
| 9  | for human consumption, in either its natural or processed state,     |
| 10 | that has been produced or processed or otherwise has had value added |
| 11 | to the product in this state. The term includes:                     |
| 12 | (A) fish or other aquatic species;                                   |
| 13 | (B) livestock, a livestock product, or a                             |
| 14 | livestock by-product;  |
| 15 | (C) planting seed;   |
| 16 | (D) poultry, a poultry product, or a poultry                         |
| 17 | <pre>by-product;</pre>   |
| 18 | (E) wildlife processed for food or by-products;                      |
| 19 | (F) a product made from a product described by                       |
| 20 | this subdivision by a farmer or other producer, including a cottage  |
| 21 | food production operation, who grew or processed the product; or     |
| 22 | (G) produce.   |
| 23 | SECTION 2. Section 437.020, Health and Safety Code, is               |
| 24 | amended by adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:    |

- 1 (b-1) The department or a local government authority,
- 2 including a local health department, may not require a person to
- 3 obtain a permit under this chapter to provide samples of food at a
- 4 farm or farmers' market under this section.
- 5 (b-2) A local government authority, including a local
- 6 health department, may not regulate the provision of samples of
- 7 food at a farm or farmers' market except as provided by this
- 8 chapter.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 437.0201(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- (e) The executive commissioner, [ex] a state [ex local]
- 12 enforcement agency, or a local government authority, including a
- 13 <u>local health department,</u> may not adopt a rule requiring a farmers'
- 14 market to pay a permit fee for:
- 15 <u>(1)</u> conducting a cooking demonstration [or providing
- 16 samples of food] if the demonstration [or provision of samples] is
- 17 conducted for a bona fide educational purpose; or
- 18 (2) providing samples of food.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
