The heading to Section 51.9356, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 51.9356. DESIGNATION OF LIAISON OFFICER TO ASSIST 7 STUDENTS WHO ARE OR WERE [FORMERLY] IN FOSTER CARE. 8 9 SECTION 2. Section 51.9356, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d), (e), and 10 11 (f) to read as follows: 12 (b) Each institution of higher education shall designate at 13 least one employee of the institution to act as a liaison officer for current and incoming students at the institution who are or were 14 formerly in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and 15 Protective Services. To the extent allowed by state or federal law, 16 the institution shall identify those students from information 17 provided to the institution in admission or financial aid 18 19 applications or other available resources. 20 (c) Each semester or other academic term, an institution of higher education shall provide to the institution's liaison officer 21 the names of and information regarding the students described by 22 23 Subsection (b).

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<u>(d)</u> The liaison officer shall provide to <u>the</u> [those]

students <u>described by Subsection (b)</u> information regarding support services and other resources available to the students at the institution and any other relevant information to assist the students.

5 <u>(e)</u> The liaison officer may participate in any training that 6 enables the officer to carry out the officer's duties and 7 coordinate with liaison officers at other educational 8 institutions.

9 <u>(f) Each institution of higher education shall publicize,</u> 10 <u>including through the institution's Internet website, social</u> 11 <u>media, electronic mail, or other means of communication used by the</u> 12 <u>institution:</u>

13 (1) the name of and contact information for the 14 institution's liaison officer; and

15 (2) information regarding support services and other 16 resources available at the institution to the students described by 17 <u>Subsection (b).</u>

18 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2020, each public 19 institution of higher education shall publicize the information 20 required by Section 51.9356(f), Education Code, as added by this 21 Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
