A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 51.9356, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.9356. DESIGNATION OF LIAISON OFFICER TO ASSIST
- 8 STUDENTS WHO ARE OR WERE [FORMERLY] IN FOSTER CARE.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 51.9356, Education Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d), (e), and
- 11 (f) to read as follows:
- 12 (b) Each institution of higher education shall designate at
- 13 least one employee of the institution to act as a liaison officer
- 14 for current and incoming students at the institution who are or were
- 15 formerly in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and
- 16 Protective Services. To the extent allowed by state or federal law,
- 17 the institution shall identify those students from information
- 18 provided to the institution in admission or financial aid
- 19 applications or other available resources.
- 20 <u>(c) Each semester or other academic term, an institution of</u>
- 21 higher education shall provide to the institution's liaison officer
- 22 the names of and information regarding the students described by
- 23 Subsection (b).
- 24 (d) The liaison officer shall provide to the [those]

- 1 students <u>described</u> by <u>Subsection</u> (b) information regarding support
- 2 services and other resources available to the students at the
- 3 institution and any other relevant information to assist the
- 4 students.
- 5 (e) The liaison officer may participate in any training that
- 6 enables the officer to carry out the officer's duties and
- 7 coordinate with liaison officers at other educational
- 8 institutions.
- 9 (f) Each institution of higher education shall publicize,
- 10 including through the institution's Internet website, social
- 11 media, electronic mail, or other means of communication used by the
- 12 institution:
- 13 <u>(1) the name of and contact information for the</u>
- 14 institution's liaison officer; and
- 15 (2) information regarding support services and other
- 16 resources available at the institution to the students described by
- 17 Subsection (b).
- 18 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2020, each public
- 19 institution of higher education shall publicize the information
- 20 required by Section 51.9356(f), Education Code, as added by this
- 21 Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
