Subchapter R, Chapter 521, Transportation Code, 7 is amended by adding Section 521.4265 to read as follows: Sec. 521.4265. TEACHER EXEMPTION. (a) In this section, 8 "teacher" means a principal, supervisor, classroom teacher, school 9 counselor, or other full-time professional employee who is required 10 to hold a certificate issued under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, 11 Education Code. 12 (b) An applicant who is, at the time of application, a 13 teacher or a retired teacher is exempt from the payment of fees 14 under this chapter for the issuance of a driver's license or 15 16 personal identification certificate. (c) The department shall require an applicant requesting an 17 exemption under this section to provide proof of the applicant's 18 entitlement to the exemption. The department shall adopt rules 19 relating to the proof of entitlement to the exemption, which may 20 include, for retired teachers, statements or other communications 21 issued by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas that evidence 22 23 payment of an annuity from the system. 24 SECTION 2. 1 by this Act, applies only to a driver's license or personal 2 identification certificate for which an application is submitted on 3 or after the effective date of this Act. A driver's license or 4 personal identification certificate for which an application was 5 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 6 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 7 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
