6	SECTION 1. Section 154.151(b), Finance Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(b) A sales contract for prepaid funeral benefits must:
9	(1) be in writing;
10	(2) state the name of the funeral provider or other
11	person primarily responsible for providing the prepaid funeral
12	benefits specified in the contract; [and]
13	(3) state the details of the prepaid funeral benefits
14	to be provided, including a description and specifications of the
15	material used in the caskets or grave vaults to be furnished; and
16	(4) state that if the funeral provider receives a dead
17	human body transferred from another funeral provider, the funeral
18	provider shall remit to the transferring funeral provider the cost
19	of the services provided by the transferring funeral provider and
20	may not charge that cost to or collect that cost from the purchaser
21	of the contract or any other party.
22	SECTION 2. Section 154.161(a), Finance Code, is amended to
23	read as follows:
24	(a) The funeral provider under a prepaid funeral benefits

1 contract subject to this chapter shall:

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(1) in compliance with applicable law, protect any
nonpublic personal financial and health information of the
purchaser and contract beneficiary in the possession of the funeral
provider;

(2) after the death of the contract beneficiary:

7 (A) deliver the contracted funeral merchandise
8 and services and cash advance items required under the contract,
9 subject to Section 154.1551;

10 (B) <u>if the funeral provider receives a dead human</u> 11 <u>body transferred from another funeral provider, remit to the</u> 12 <u>transferring funeral provider the cost of the services provided by</u> 13 <u>the transferring funeral provider and may not charge the cost to or</u> 14 <u>collect the cost from the purchaser of the contract or any other</u> 15 <u>party;</u>

16 (C) prepare a written pre-need to at-need 17 reconciliation to verify that the specified goods and services are 18 delivered or performed for the agreed price and promptly refund any 19 contract overcharges that may be revealed by the reconciliation;

20 <u>(D)</u> [(C)] if advance payment of cash advance 21 items was included in the contract, prepare a reconciliation of 22 proceeds applied to cash advance items; and

(E) [(D)] retain a copy of each reconciliation
 until the third anniversary of the date of service; and

(3) with respect to each prepaid funeral benefits
 contract for which the funeral provider is not also the seller:
 (A) sign the reconciliations required by

1 Subdivision (2);

(B) promptly deliver the records that verify contract performance to the seller, including the final at-need contract, the certificate of performance, and the reconciliations required under Subdivision (2);

6 (C) if requested by the seller, correct or 7 explain any discrepancy in a reconciliation required under 8 Subdivision (2);

9 (D) subject to Subsection (d), provide copies of 10 any other records or documentation related to the offer, sale, and 11 performance of the contract that are reasonably requested by the 12 seller or the department, including records related to any refund 13 required by Section 154.1511 or 154.1551; and

14 (E) inform each seller with which the funeral 15 provider has an outstanding contract of any closure of the 16 provider's funeral establishments not later than the 15th day after 17 the date of closure.

SECTION 3. Section 651.406, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

(e) A funeral establishment that receives a dead human body 20 transferred from another funeral establishment shall include in the 21 purchase agreement any amount owed by the customer to the 22 transferring funeral establishment. The recipient 23 funeral 24 establishment shall remit to the transferring funeral establishment any amount collected on behalf of the transferring 25 26 funeral establishment.

SECTION 4. Sections 154.151(b) and 154.161(a), Finance

Code, as amended by this Act, and Section 651.406(e), Occupations 1 Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a sales contract or 2 purchase agreement entered into or renewed on or after the 3 4 effective date of this Act. A sales contract or purchase agreement entered into or renewed before the effective date of this Act is 5 6 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 8
