- 7 SUBCHAPTER D. FUNERAL ESCORT SERVICE VEHICLES
- 8 Sec. 546.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "funeral
- 9 escort service" means a business that facilitates the movement of
- 10 traffic for a funeral procession.
- 11 Sec. 546.102. FUNERAL ESCORT SERVICES. A local authority
- 12 shall allow a funeral escort service to facilitate the movement of
- 13 <u>traffic for a funeral procession.</u>
- 14 Sec. 546.103. OPERATOR TRAINING. A person may operate a
- 15 vehicle to facilitate the movement of a funeral procession for a
- 16 funeral escort service only if the person has successfully
- 17 <u>completed a training program in traffic direction as defined</u> by the
- 18 basic peace officer course curriculum established by the Texas
- 19 <u>Commission on Law Enforcement.</u>
- 20 <u>Sec. 546.104.</u> OPERATION OF FUNERAL ESCORT SERVICE VEHICLES.
- 21 An operator of a vehicle facilitating the movement of a funeral
- 22 procession for a funeral escort service may proceed past a red or
- 23 stop signal or stop sign, after slowing as necessary for safe
- 24 operation.

- 2 relieve the operator of a funeral escort service vehicle from:
- 3 (1) the duty to operate the vehicle with appropriate
- 4 regard for the safety of all persons; or
- 5 (2) the consequences of reckless disregard for the
- 6 safety of others.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
