- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 546, Transportation Code, is amended by 6 adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

- 8 Sec. 546.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "funeral
- 9 escort service" means a business that facilitates the movement of
- 10 traffic for a funeral procession.
- 11 Sec. 546.102. LIMITATION ON LOCAL AUTHORITIES. A local
- 12 authority may not prohibit a funeral escort service from
- 13 facilitating the movement of traffic for a funeral procession.
- 14 Sec. 546.103. OPERATION OF FUNERAL ESCORT SERVICE VEHICLES.
- 15 An operator of a vehicle facilitating the movement of a funeral
- 16 procession for a funeral escort service may proceed past a red or
- 17 stop signal or stop sign, after slowing as necessary for safe
