4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 171, Civil Practice and
5	Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 171.004 to read as
6	follows:
7	Sec. 171.004. APPLICABILITY OF LIMITATIONS PERIODS. (a) A
8	party may not assert a claim in an arbitration proceeding if the
9	party could not bring suit for the claim in court due to the
10	expiration of the applicable limitations period.
11	(b) A party may assert a claim in an arbitration proceeding
12	after expiration of the applicable limitations period if:
13	(1) the party brought suit for the claim in court
14	before the expiration of the applicable limitations period; and
15	(2) a court ordered the parties to arbitrate the
16	<u>claim.</u>
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
