- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 259.002, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 259.002. REQUIREMENTS FOR PRACTICING SURGICAL
- 8 TECHNOLOGY; CONTINUING EDUCATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 259.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows:
- 11 (d) A person employed by a health care facility to practice
- 12 surgical technology under Subsection (a)(1) shall complete the
- 13 <u>number of hours of continuing education required to maintain</u>
- 14 certification by the organization that issued the surgical
- 15 technologist certification to the person. On the facility's
- 16 request, the person shall submit to the facility evidence of
- 17 completion of the continuing education.
- 18 (e) A person employed by a health care facility to practice
- 19 <u>surgical technology under Subsection (a)(2) or (3) or Subsection</u>
- 20 (c) shall complete every two years 30 hours of continuing education
- 21 related to surgical technology. On the facility's request, the
- 22 person shall submit to the facility evidence of completion of the
- 23 continuing education.
- 24 (f) A health care facility may restrict the ability of a

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- 1 person employed by the facility to practice surgical technology in
- 2 the facility if the person fails to complete the continuing
- 3 education required by Subsection (d) or (e).
- 4 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Sections 259.002(d) and (e),
- 5 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, a person employed by a
- 6 health care facility to practice surgical technology is not
- 7 required to complete the continuing education before September 1,
- 8 2020.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
