A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to continuing education requirements for surgical 3 technologists. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 259.002, Health and 5 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 259.002. REQUIREMENTS FOR PRACTICING SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY; CONTINUING EDUCATION. 8 SECTION 2. Section 259.002, Health and Safety Code, is 9 amended by adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows: 10 11 (d) A person employed by a health care facility to practice 12 surgical technology under Subsection (a)(1) shall complete the number of hours of continuing education required to maintain 13 certification by the organization that issued the surgical 14 technologist certification to the person. On the facility's 15 request, the person shall submit to the facility evidence of 16 satisfactory completion of the continuing education. 17 18 (e) A person employed by a health care facility to practice surgical technology under Subsection (a)(2), (3), or (4) or 19 Subsection (c) shall complete every two years 30 hours of 20 21 continuing education related to surgical technology and submit to the facility evidence of satisfactory completion of the continuing 22 23 education. 24 (f) A health care facility may restrict the ability of a

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person employed by the facility to practice surgical technology in the facility if the person fails to complete the continuing education required by Subsection (d) or (e). SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Sections 259.002(d) and (e), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, a person employed by a health care facility to practice surgical technology is not required to complete the continuing education before September 1,

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
