- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), a [A] public
- 10 junior college may offer a baccalaureate degree program under this
- 11 subchapter only if its junior college district:
- 12 (1) had a taxable property valuation amount of not
- 13 less than \$6 billion in the preceding year; and
- 14 (2) received a positive assessment of the overall
- 15 financial health of the district as reported by the coordinating
- 16 board.
- 17 (b-1) The requirement of Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to
- 18 <u>Navarro College</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
