- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 382.0622(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Clean Air Act fees consist of:
- 8 (1) fees collected by the commission under Sections
- 9 382.062, 382.0621, 382.202, and 382.302 and as otherwise provided
- 10 by law;
- 11 (2) $\$4 \ [\$2]$ from the portion of each fee collected for
- 12 inspections of vehicles other than mopeds and remitted to the state
- 13 under <u>Sections</u>] 548.501 [and 548.503], Transportation
- 14 Code; and
- 15 (3) fees collected that are required under Section 185
- 16 of the federal Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. Section 7511d).
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 548.051, Transportation Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 548.051. VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT SUBJECT TO REGULAR
- 20 INSPECTION. (a) A motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, pole
- 21 trailer, or mobile home, registered in this state, must have the
- 22 following items inspected biennially at an inspection station or by
- 23 an inspector:

- 3 OF PASSING VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 548.103, Transportation Code, is
- 5 transferred to Subchapter E, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 6 redesignated as Section 548.2571, Transportation Code, and amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 548.2571 [548.103]. EXTENDED INSPECTION PERIOD FOR
- 9 CERTAIN VEHICLES. The department may extend the time within which
- 10 the resident owner of a vehicle that is not in this state when an
- 11 inspection is required must <u>have the</u> [obtain a] vehicle <u>inspected</u>
- 12 [inspection report in this state].
- SECTION 5. Section 548.254, Transportation Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 548.254. VALIDITY OF VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT. The
- 16 department, and the conservation commission if necessary, by rule
- 17 shall establish the length of time a [A] vehicle inspection report
- 18 required by this chapter is valid [invalid after the end of the 12th
- 19 month following the month in which the report is issued].
- SECTION 6. Subchapter E, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 21 is amended by adding Section 548.257 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 548.257. TIMING OF INSPECTION FOR REGISTRATION-BASED</u>
- 23 ENFORCEMENT. The department shall require a vehicle required to be
- 24 inspected under this chapter to pass the required inspection:
- 25 (1) for initial registration, not earlier than 90 days
- 26 before the date of registration;
- 27 (2) for a renewal of registration, not earlier than 90

- 1 days before the date of expiration of the vehicle's registration;
- 2 (3) if the vehicle is a used motor vehicle sold by a
- 3 dealer, as defined by Section 503.001, in the 180 days preceding the
- 4 date the dealer sells the vehicle; or
- 5 (4) if the vehicle is subject to the federal motor
- 6 carrier safety regulations, in a period that complies with those
- 7 <u>regulations.</u>
- 8 SECTION 7. Sections 548.501(a) and (b), Transportation
- 9 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) Except as provided by <u>Section</u> [Sections 548.503 and]
- 11 548.504, the fee for inspection of a [motor] vehicle under Section
- 12 548.051(a) [other than a moped] is \$18.50 [\$12.50]. The fee for
- inspection of a moped under Section 548.051(b) is \$5.75.
- 14 (b) Out of each fee for an inspection of a vehicle other than
- 15 <u>a moped</u>, \$11.50 [\$5.50] shall be remitted to the state under Section
- 16 548.509. Out of each fee for an inspection of a moped, \$5.50 shall
- 17 be remitted to the state under Section 548.509.
- SECTION 8. Section 548.502, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 Sec. 548.502. INSPECTION BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR STATE
- 21 AGENCY. A political subdivision or state agency for which the
- 22 department certifies an inspection station under Section 548.004:
- (1) shall pay to the state \$11.50 [\$5.50] for each
- 24 inspection under Section 548.051(a) [548.509]; and
- 25 (2) may not be required to pay the remainder of the
- 26 inspection fee.
- 27 SECTION 9. Section 548.505(a), Transportation Code, is

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1 amended to read as follows:
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- 2 (a) The department by rule may impose an inspection fee for
- 3 a vehicle inspected under Section 548.301(a) in addition to the fee
- 4 provided by Section 548.501, 548.502, [548.503,] or 548.504. A fee
- 5 imposed under this subsection must be based on the costs of:
- 6 (1) providing inspections; and
- 7 (2) administering the program.
- 8 SECTION 10. Sections 548.101, 548.102, and 548.503,
- 9 Transportation Code, are repealed.
- 10 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
