7	(a) A parole officer annually shall identify the releasees
8	under the parole officer's supervision who are eligible for early
9	release from supervision under Section 508.155(c). A releasee is
10	eligible for early release if:
11	(1) the releasee has been under supervision for the

13	(A) [at least] one-half of the time that remained
14	on the releasee's sentence when the releasee was released from
15	imprisonment; or
16	(B) 10 years;
17	(2) during the preceding two-year period, the releasee
18	has not committed any violation of the rules or conditions of
19	release;

and

(A) that the releasee has made a good faith

parole or release to mandatory supervision has not been revoked;

(4) the division determines:

- 1 effort to comply with any restitution order imposed on the releasee
- 2 by a court; and
- 3 (B) that allowing the releasee to serve the
- 4 remainder of the releasee's sentence without supervision and
- 5 reporting is in the best interest of society.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 7 person on parole or mandatory supervision on or after the effective
- 8 date of this Act, regardless of whether the person was released on
- 9 parole or to mandatory supervision before, on, or after that date.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
