A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the early release from supervision of certain persons 3 released on parole or to mandatory supervision. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 508.1555(a), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 7 A parole officer annually shall identify the releasees (a) under the parole officer's supervision who are eligible for early 8 release from supervision under Section 508.155(c). A releasee is 9 eligible for early release if: 10 11 (1) the releasee has been under supervision for the 12 lesser of: 13 (A) [at least] one-half of the time that remained 14 on the releasee's sentence when the releasee was released from 15 imprisonment; or 16 (B) 10 years; (2) during the preceding two-year period, the releasee 17 has not committed any violation of the rules or conditions of 18 19 release; during the period of supervision the releasee's 20 (3) parole or release to mandatory supervision has not been revoked; 21 22 and the division determines: (4) 23 24 (A) that the releasee has made a good faith

H.B. No. 17531 effort to comply with any restitution order imposed on the releasee2 by a court; and

3 (B) that allowing the releasee to serve the 4 remainder of the releasee's sentence without supervision and 5 reporting is in the best interest of society.

6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 7 person on parole or mandatory supervision on or after the effective 8 date of this Act, regardless of whether the person was released on 9 parole or to mandatory supervision before, on, or after that date.
