A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the consideration of employee compensation and benefits
- 3 in establishing the rates of gas utilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 104, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 104.060 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 104.060. CONSIDERATION OF COMPENSATION AND BENEFIT
- 8 EXPENSES. (a) In this section, "employee compensation and
- 9 benefits" includes base salaries, wages, incentive compensation,
- 10 and benefits. The term does not include pension and other
- 11 postemployment benefits.
- (b) When establishing a gas utility's rates, the regulatory
- 13 authority shall presume that employee compensation and benefits
- 14 expenses are reasonable and necessary if the expenses are
- 15 consistent with recent market compensation studies.
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 104.060, Utilities Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, applies only to a proceeding for the establishment of
- 18 rates for which the regulatory authority has not issued a final
- 19 order or decision before the effective date of this Act.
- 20 (b) A proceeding for which the regulatory authority has
- 21 issued a final order or decision before the effective date of this
- 22 Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date,
- 23 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
