6 SECTION 1. Section 263.401, Family Code, is amended by

adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows: 7

(b-2) When considering under Subsection (b) whether to find 8

9 that extraordinary circumstances necessitate the child remaining

in the temporary managing conservatorship of the department for a 10

case in which the court orders a parent to complete a substance 11

12 abuse treatment program, the court shall consider whether the

parent made a good faith effort to successfully complete the 13

14 program.

SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 15

a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after 16

the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child 17

relationship filed before that date is governed by the law in effect 18

on the date the suit was filed, and that law is continued in effect 19

20 for that purpose.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
