A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to public comments on matters subject to a hearing under 3 the jurisdiction of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 5.555, Water Code, is amended to read as 6 follows:

Sec. 5.555. RESPONSE TO 7 AND CONSIDERATION OF PUBLIC The executive director, in accordance with 8 COMMENTS. (a) 9 procedures provided by commission rule, shall file with the chief clerk of the commission a response to each [relevant and material] 10 public comment on the preliminary decision filed during the public 11 12 comment period.

(b) The chief clerk of the commission shall transmit the executive director's decision, <u>the public comments made during the</u> <u>public comment period</u>, the executive director's <u>responses</u> [<u>response</u>] to public comments, and instructions for requesting that the commission reconsider the executive director's decision or hold a contested case hearing to:

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(1) the applicant;

20 (2) any person who submitted comments during the21 public comment period; and

(3) any person who requested to be on the mailing listfor the permit action.

24 (c) The commission shall consider all public comments

1 <u>submitted during the public comment period when deciding on an</u> 2 <u>action related to an application.</u>

3 SECTION 2. Section 5.555, Water Code, as amended by this 4 Act, applies only to a permit application filed with the Texas 5 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date 6 of this Act. A permit application filed before the effective date 7 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, 8 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
