A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to increasing the criminal penalty for certain boating 3 while intoxicated offenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 49.06, Penal Code, is amended 5 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 7 follows: (b) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (c) or</u> Section 49.09, 8 9 an offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor, with a minimum term of confinement of 72 hours. 10 11 (c) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this 12 section that an analysis of a specimen of the person's blood, breath, or urine showed an alcohol concentration level of 0.15 or 13 14 more at the time the analysis was performed, the offense is a Class A misdemeanor. 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 20 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 22 23 before that date.
