A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to county regulation of roadside vendors and solicitors. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 285.001(a), Transportation Code, 4 is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of (a) 7 a county with a population of more than 1.3 million and a county with a population of more than 550,000 that is adjacent to a county 8 with a population of four million by order may regulate the 9 following in the unincorporated area of the county if they occur on 10 a public highway or road, in the right-of-way of a public highway or 11 12 road, or in a parking lot: 13 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or 14 merchandise, including live animals; (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of 15 а 16 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live 17 animals; and 18 (3) the solicitation of money. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
